#### Location

The IFRA Italia Conference will take place at the Congress Center in Sirmione, on the southern shore of the Lake of Garda, a few hundred metres from historical downtown Sirmione. The Congress Center offers ample parking.

**Reaching Rocca Visconteo Veneta di Lonato del Garda:** Participants arriving in Sirmione on June 18 can travel to the Rocca by coach. **IFRA Italia Coaches will head to the Rocca at 19.30h leaving from the parking area in front of the Congress Center in Sirmione**.

For participants travelling directly to the Rocca by car, we would recommend: Highway A4 Milano-Venezia, Exit "Desenzano del Garda", continue to Lonato for approx. 4 kms. When in downtown Lonato, from Piazza del Corlo drive into Via dei Fanti. Skip the first public parking area on the right side and go straight to the top of the hill. Leave your car in the area close to the draw-bridge of the Rocca. For participants using a Navigator, we recommend entering "Lonato, Piazza del Corlo" as your destination, providing easy access to Via dei Fanti.
